What are the G-category high-speed trains like?

G-category high-speed trains have 2nd class seats, 1st class seats & business class seats. 1st class seats are 2-abreast each side of the aisle, 2nd class seats are 3-abreast one side and 2 abreast the other. Business class has individual reclining seats with footrest and a meal is included in the fare. Some business class seats are located in the train's end car behind the driver and these are sometimes called VIP or Sightseeing seats. Indeed, on the shorter trainsets typically used on the fastest trains with 1 & 2-digit train numbers (for example G3 or G10), this is the only business class area on the train. On the longer trainsets typically used on the slightly slower trains with 3-digit train numbers (for example G101) there's a normal business class coach as well as business class seats in a VIP/sightseeing area, but it's not possible to specify which type of business class seat you want. The longer trainsets have a restaurant car. Several slower D-category daytime trains taking 7 hours also use the high-speed line with cheaper fares, but these aren't shown below.

Beijing is a metropolis in northern China and the capital of the People's Republic of China.

It is one of the four municipalities of the PRC, which are equivalent to provinces in China's administrative structure.

The municipality of Beijing borders Hebei Province to the north, west, south, and for a small section in the east, and Tianjin Municipality to the southeast.

Beijing is one of the Four Great Ancient Capitals of China.

Beijing is China's second largest city, after Shanghai.

Beijing is a major transportation hub, with dozens of railways, roads and motorways passing through the city. It is also the focal point of many international flights to China.

Beijing is recognised as the political, educational, and cultural center of the People's Republic of China, while Shanghai and Hong Kong predominate in economic fields.

The city hosted the 2008 Olympic Games.

Beijing (Peking) is one of the great cities of the world and famous for its long history and splendid culture. It has been the capital for the last 700 years and is the second largest city in China. Its long history has endowed the city with countless historic and scenic spots. Beijing is filled with great monuments, palaces, temples and reminders of the past glory of imperial China. Situated in the northeast of China, it is the center of national politics and culture and the hub for international communication. It has an overall population of 10,855,000 and covers an area of 16,808 square kilometers at an elevation of 43.5 m above sea level. The climate in Beijing is seasonal with cold, dry winters and hot summers. Beijing is a tourist city famed for its picturesque scenery. Autumn is the peak season, when the weather is dry and cooler. You can visit the largest and best-preserved ancient palace, the Imperial Palace, the most well preserved royal garden, the Summer Palace, and the world-famous Great Wall. The Imperial Palace represents the crystallization of ancient Chinese architecture. The Summer Palace has a concentration of the best of ancient buildings, as well as styles of gardening, and is a virtual museum of traditional Chinese gardening. The Great Wall, a huge project that began more than 2,000 years ago, winds its way along the mountains and valleys bordering northern China and approaches quite close to Beijing. Today, with its magnificent Tiananmen Square, its network of cloverleaf road junctions and its skyline of high-rises, Beijing has taken on a new look, blending classical grace with hi-tech modernity. The grand, magnificent Tiananmen Square stands harmoniously in the vicinity of crisscrossing cloverleaf junctions and serried skyscrapers. Simple, classical tradition synchronizes perfectly with contemporary civilization: Beijing, this ancient city, has taken on a brand-new look.

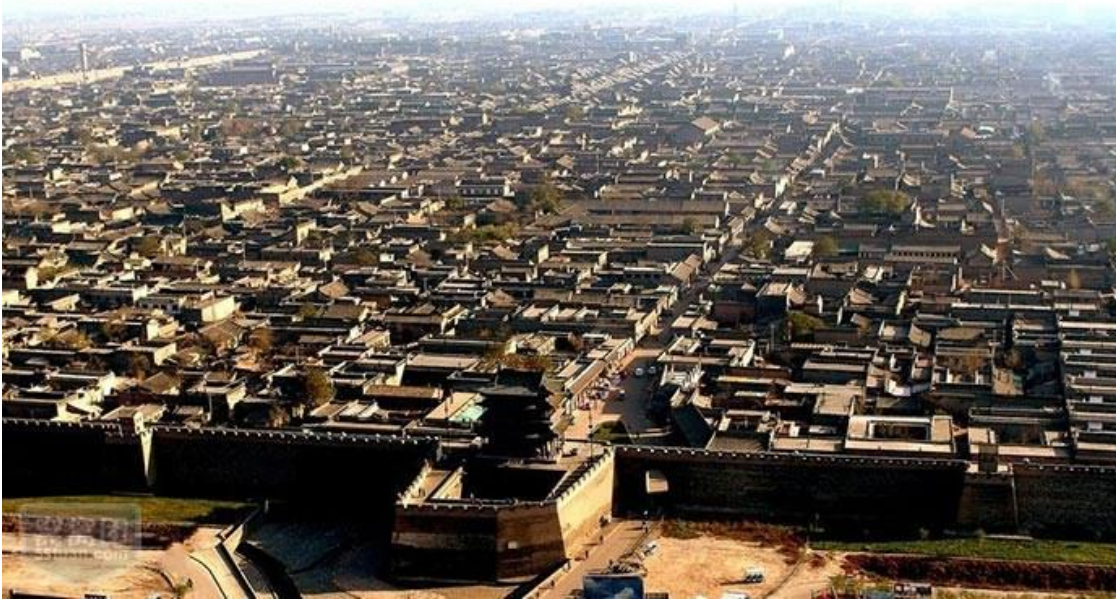


Beijing's climate is defined as "continental monsoon." The four seasons are distinctly recognizable. Spring and autumn is the best time to be in Beijing, particularly in the months of April, May, September and October. Autumn is considered to be the best time to visit Beijing as the skies are clear and the weather is very comfortable. The four seasons are very clear in Beijing with a temperate spring, rainy summer, clear autumn, and a cold, snowy winter. The average temperature throughout the year is 11.8POP. The coldest month is January with an average temperature of -4.6POP and the hottest month is July at an average temperature of 26.1POP. Unfortunately, spring and autumn are shorter than summer and winter. Although winter is technically longer, that should not keep you from traveling to Beijing as indoor heating is widely available. Nevertheless, as the indoor/outdoor temperature difference is rather large, travelers should be prepared with warm clothing and a thick coat is recommended for the colder months of the year. In winter, off-season discounts are to be had as well. Bilingual weather information can be obtained by dialing 12121 when in Beijing. The average precipitation in a year is 644 mm. The frost-free period is 180-days.

Pingyao

is a Chinese city and county in central Shanxi province, China. It lies about 715 km from Beijing and 80 km from the provincial capital, Taiyuan. During the Qing Dynasty, Pingyao was a financial center of China. It is now renowned for its well-preserved ancient city wall, and is a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Historical Importance

Pingyao still retains its city layout from the Ming and Qing dynasties, conforming to a typical bagua pattern. More than 300 sites in or near the city have ancient ruins. Preserved Ming- and Qing-style residences number close to 4,000. The streets and storefronts still largely retain their historical appearance. In the Spring and Autumn Period, the county belonged to the kingdom of Jin. It became a World Heritage Site in 1997.

The City Walls

The city walls of Pingyao were constructed in the 3rd year of the Hongwu Emperor (1370). The walls have six barbican gates. The north and south sides have one gate each. The east and west sides have two gates each. This pattern is similar to that of a turtle (the head, tail, and four legs), earning Pingyao the moniker "Turtle City."

Finance

Pingyao was the financial center of China in the late Qing Dynasty. During those times, there were as many as 20 financial institutions within the city, comprising more than half of total in the whole country. Among these is "Rishengchang," considered the first bank in China.

Harbin, the renowned 'Ice City', is located in the south of Heilongjiang Province, the most northeastern part of China with a shape of a swan when viewed on a map. Not only for the city's special position, but also as the center of Heilongjiang's political, economic, educational and cultural life, Harbin is described as the pearl beneath the swan's neck, and plays a vital role in communications between South and North Asia as well the regions of Europe and the Pacific Ocean.

Being the famous 'Ice City', Harbin attracts visitors from home and abroad by the [Harbin Ice and Snow Festival](#) it holds each year. It is a happy carnival which provides visitors a whole world of ice and snow. The festival usually begins from January and last for over one month.

Before you visit a city, it is always useful to know at least a little of its history. It was the birthplace of Jin (1115-1234) and Qing (1644-1911) Dynasties, the latter of which had a very considerable influence on modern Chinese history. At the end of the 19th century, Russia built the terminus of the Middle East Railway here. Later, more than 160,000 foreigners from 33 countries migrated to this place, promoting the development of a capitalist economy in the city. The economy and culture of Harbin achieved unprecedented prosperity at that time and the city gradually grew into a famous international commercial port. Assimilating external culture, the city created its unique and exotic cityscape. The majestic [St. Sofia Orthodox Church](#) and [Zhongyang Daijie](#) each built in a European style have the effect of bringing you into an 'eastern Moscow'. Even though you are sure to be attracted by various exotic buildings, the Dragon Tower which embodies the wisdom of the Chinese people is a must on your journey.
